Dear Glen Burnie Families,

On March 3, we held our third Teacher - Parent Conference Day of this school year. This is the first year the school district has dedicated three calendar days toward these conferences. Looking back, I am extremely pleased at the opportunity that these days have provided for you to develop relationships with our staff. This year, the Parent Conference Days brought teachers and parents together for over 600 meetings. We all know the adage that, "It takes a village to raise a child." We have felt the positive impact of these conferences this year as we have been able to partner with you to form that much-needed "village" of support around your children.

In that same sense, we have been grateful for the support parents have provided through our first annual series of "Parent Café." Parent Café gives parents, administrators and teachers a chance to have an open, informal dialogue about anything happening in our school community. Our next parent Café will be on Thursday, April 6 from 7:30 - 8:30 am. I hope you will join us for that event.

One of the topics we feel is important to discuss with parents is student attendance. Attendance has been an area in which our school is concentrating our efforts to improve. Our attendance rate is 90% this school year, significantly lower than our neighboring high schools. We will be holding an attendance competition this month, with students who have perfect attendance earning a ticket to our faculty-student basketball game. We hope that you will continue to support us in our efforts to improve attendance at Glen Burnie High School by getting your child to school on time every day.

As we look forward to the end of the school year, we have some important dates on the horizon for testing. On April 19th, all students in the eleventh grade will take the ACT test. This is a college entrance exam similar to the SAT. We are fortunate to be able to offer this exam at no cost to all juniors during the school day. We are also looking ahead to the Advanced Placement (AP) exams during the first two weeks in May. Registration deadlines for those exams have passed. Finally, this weekend our Theater Company will be staging a production of Macbeth on Friday and Saturday evenings. All ninth grade English students will have a chance to have a sneak peek at Macbeth this Thursday during 2<sup>nd</sup> period. This is a play that all 9<sup>th</sup> grade students read in their English course. If you have a chance to bring your child out to see the full production, we strongly encourage you to do so.

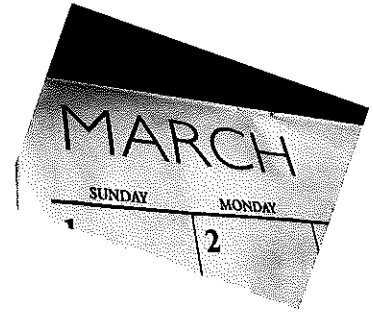
As always, I continue to encourage you to stay involved with your child's education. We are always here to answer your questions and welcome your presence at all school events.

### Career Talk:

#### "What Problems Do You Want to Solve?"

Educational researcher and lecturer, Dr. Katie Martin, shared insights for talking with even our youngest children about their career dreams in this fast-changing world. She recently wrote, "Realistically, the job a child ends up doing may not yet exist." She notes that kids' career focus is strongly influenced by adults' ideas of what is "best," and that these can be based on unconscious gender and class bias. "We want our children to have opportunities to build on their strengths, explore their passions and be empowered to solve problems that matter to them." Dr. Martin quotes education expert, Jaime Casap, who urges, "Don't ask kids what they want to be when they grow up but what *problems* they want to solve." Guide children toward those workplaces of the future by asking:

- ❖ What do you love to do?
- ❖ How do you like to work and play with others?
- ❖ What do you want to learn more about?
- ❖ What is important to you?

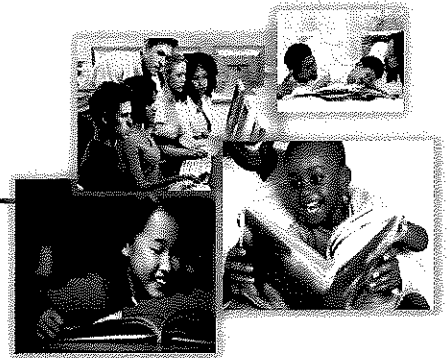

Investigador Educativo y Profesor, Dr. Katie Martin, compartió sus ideas para hablar incluso con los niños más pequeños de sus sueños de carrera en este mundo rápidamente cambiando. 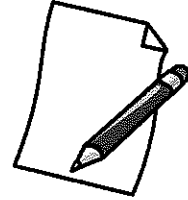

# From the Attendance Office

Has the student missed school?

Please send in notes for days missed to the Attendance Office or the student's teacher. If you have a doctor's note, please include that as well. Your note must include the following important information:



- the **students full name**
- date of absence
- reason for absence
- parent/guardian name and telephone number

## **\*\*FAST PASS\*\*** **Early Dismissals**

If you know your student will be leaving early, please write a note for the early dismissal (include: student name, date, time of dismissal, reason for leaving, parent/guardian name and phone number).

1. The student will bring that note to the Attendance Office in exchange for a pink pass.
2. The student will show the teacher the pink pass then leave at the appropriate time indicated on the pass.
3. You need to sign out the student but this process will ensure a fast dismissal.
